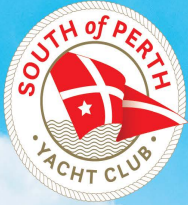

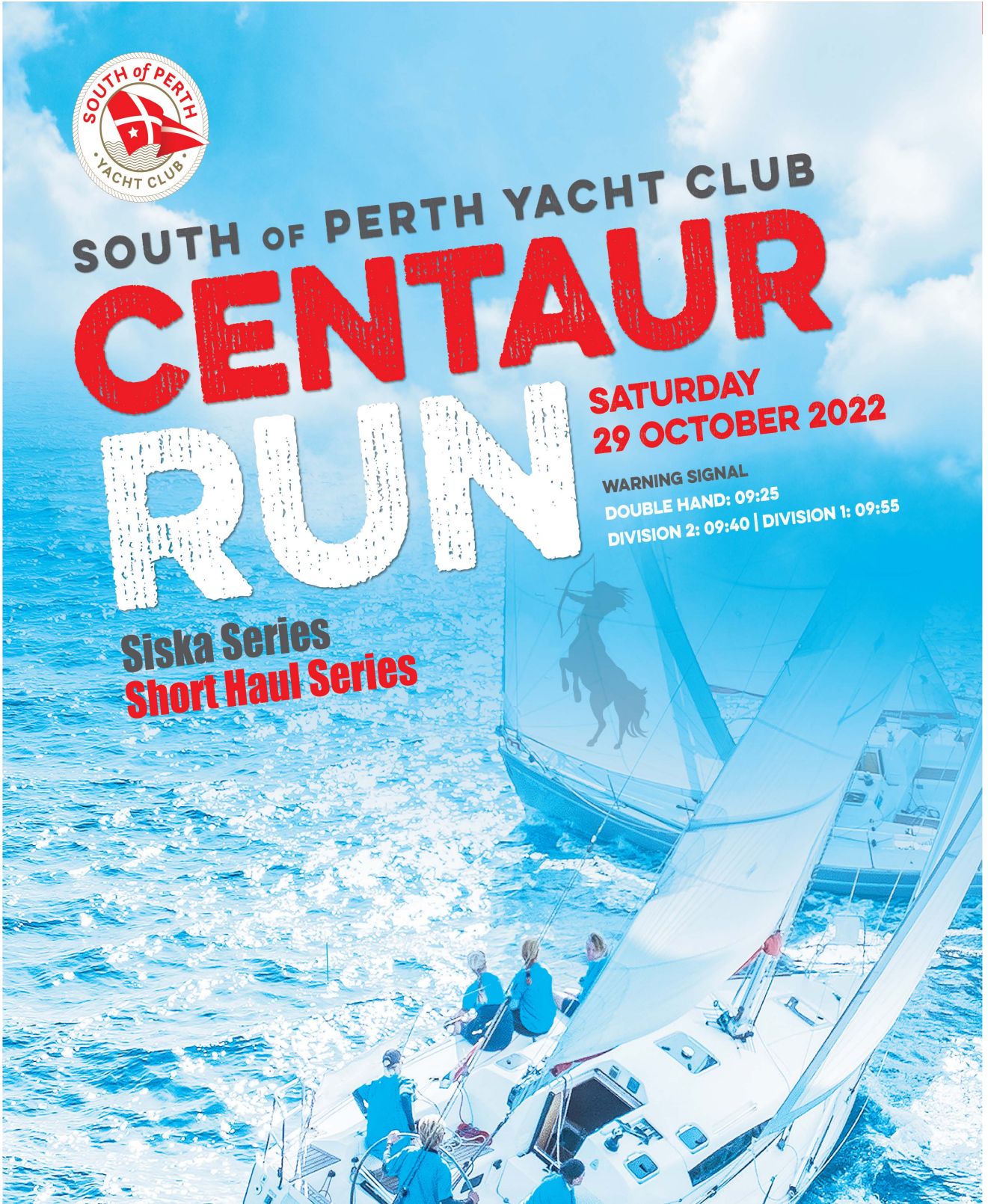

<b>Start Boat</b>		“Coffee Point” – Displaying with an SoPYC burgee.
<b>Marks</b>	SI 9 & 9.2	“port end start buoy” shall be cylindrical, black and white checkered.  ‘Day Buoy’ shall be a cylindrical yellow buoy.
<b>Amendments</b>	SI 8.1	In the map, delete “North Cottesloe”, replace with “Swanbourne”
<b>Signals made ashore</b>		Will be displayed on the main flag mast on the lawn at the western side of the Fremantle Sailing Clubhouse.
<b>Listening watch</b>	NoR 5	VHF 16 AND VHF 72
<b>Race channels</b>	SI 4	VHF 72
<b>Shorten course</b>	SI 7	[NP] Shortening Course Signals may be broadcast on VHF 72. This is in addition to the requirements of RRS 32.
<b>Penalty system</b>	SI 16	RRS 44.1 is changed so that the two-turns penalty is replaced by the one-turn penalty.
<b>Hearing requests</b>	SI 17	A ‘request for a hearing’ shall be in writing and lodged with the Race Committee within 60 minutes after the finishing time of the last boat in the relevant fleet in its last race of the day. If required, hearing request forms are available from:  <a href="https://sopyc.com.au/keelboats/protests/">https://sopyc.com.au/keelboats/protests/</a>  In the event of a protest as per RRS 61.1(a), the protesting boat shall also inform the other boat by radio on VHF 72 at the first reasonable opportunity.
<b>Radio check / logging on</b>	SI 19.1	Call sign - ‘Offshore Race Control’ on VHF 72 From 0830hrs up until the first warning signal.
<b>Position reports (Cat 2 &amp; 3 races)</b>	SI 19.2 & 19.3	Scheduled position reports as specified in SI 19.2 will not be required.



<b>Rounding reports</b>	SI 19.4 & 19.5	As per Section 3, below.
<b>Trackers</b>	SI 20	Will not be provided for this race
<b>Time limit</b>		Not applicable for this race
<b>Announcement of Results</b>		Results will be announced & prizes presented on Wednesday 2 <sup>nd</sup> November at SoPYC at 1800, in conjunction with SoPYC Midweek keelboat results.
