# C FLEET

## MIDWEEK SERIES PURSUIT RACES

SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2018 – 2019 Season

### 1. RULES

Races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the South of Perth Yacht Club Midweek Series Sailing Instructions 2018-19 and as modified by these Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

### 2. STARTING

2.1 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal is 1450.

2.2 C fleet shall start in accordance with the following pursuit race signals:

| Signal            | Flag and Sound                                       | Minutes before starting signal |
|-------------------|--|--------------------------------|
| Warning           | C Fleet Flag displayed,<br>'00' displayed<br>1 sound | 5                              |
| 1 minute to Start | 1 long sound   | 1                              |
| First Start       | 1 sound<br>Pursuit Race Start Time '00' displayed    | 0                              |

- Start times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded. This changes RRS 26.
- Pursuit race start times will be displayed in sequence from '00' from the first start signal and increasing in one-minute intervals.
- Boats shall start when their start time is displayed.
- A boat which starts before its allocated start time will be penalised by adding two minutes to its finish time plus one minute for each full or part minute early.
- No recall signals will be made. This changes RRS 29.
- Individual boat start times will be available online at least one day prior to each race.

### 3. COURSES

3.1 Courses will be set using the following table as a guide:

- Course 2 – Wind 14 knots and above
- Course 3 – Wind 10 to 13 knots
- Course 4 – Wind 9 knots or below

3.2 Boats shall start in a northerly direction. The displaying of Flag V shall be disregarded.

3.3 There will be no shortening of courses before or after the start. This changes RRS 32

### 4. TIME LIMIT

The time limit is 1715.

### 5. PRIZES

Pennants will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in order across the line.
