## INVITATION KEELBOAT RACE

# NOTICE OF RACE

South of Perth Yacht Club invites eligible SoPYC and RPYC Keelboats to participate in the Jane Brook Wines Invitation Race on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than a disqualification.

### 1. RULES

1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in:

- a) The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- b) The Prescriptions of Australian Sailing (AS) including the Special Regulations Category 7.
- c) The Performance Handicap Rules (PHS) of SoPYC and RPYC.
- d) The SoPYC Midweek Sailing Instructions (SIs) and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs) issued for this event.
- e) Appendix T – Arbitration will apply.

1.2 Racing Rules will be changes as follows:

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for this race.

1.3 **Sails**

- a) Boats may only carry normal working sails tacked in the normal position for working to windward. Boats shall not use asymmetrical spinnakers or the like.
- b) A sail may be attached to a bowsprit or poled out. This changes RRS 50.3

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to all boats registered with either SoPYC or RPYC in the following Wednesday Midweek divisions:

2.2 Boats shall satisfy the following requirements for her entry to be accepted:

- a) Have submitted a completed AS Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form with either club.
- b) Hold a valid third-party liability insurance policy with a minimum cover of \$10 million dollars per incident or the equivalent. It is strongly recommended that such insurance include a racing extension.

- c) For scoring purposes, the helmsperson of a Keelboat may be substituted by a club member who regularly crews on that Keelboat.
- 2.3 Boats shall already be registered via their respective Club's Keelboat entry portal.

### 4. SCORING

- 4.1 All boats will be allocated a PHS (Performance Based Handicap) by the respective Club Handicappers.
- 4.2 SoPYC and RPYC boats will be scored separately.

### 5. OFFICIAL BOATS

All official boats will display the words 'Safety'.

### 6. SAFETY [DP]

- 6.1 No anchors shall be carried on deck forward of the stem or any part protruding outboard.
- 6.2 Operable marine VHF radios shall be carried, which may be permanently installed or be waterproof handheld and shall be turned on whilst racing.
- 6.3 All sailors competing double-handed shall wear a PFD Type 1, level 100 or higher which conforms to AS 4758 or ISO 12402 or AAS 1512.
- 6.4 In addition to the Helmsperson, there shall be at least one crew member who shall be competent to handle the boat in an emergency.

### 7. PRIZES

- 7.1 Pennants will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> in each division and class.
- 7.2 Results will be made available on the SoPYC website as soon as practical.
- 7.3 Results presentations will be announced in the Quarterdeck area of the main clubhouse no earlier than 1800.

### 8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

### 9. MEDIA

By participating in the event, competitors grant to the organizing authority and Australian Sailing and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
