1. RULES

- 1.1 The Organising Authority (OA) is South of Perth Yacht Club (Inc.)
- 1.2 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in:
- a) The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
 - b) The Prescriptions of Australian Sailing (AS) including the Special Regulations
 - c) The Class Rules of the SS27
 - d) The SS27 Sailing Instructions
 - e) The South of Perth Yacht Club Saturday Summer Series Sailing Instructions 2021-22
 - f) And as modified by these Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

2. NOMINAL STARTING ORDER

3. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the race noticeboard located in the foyer of the Clubhouse. The race office is in the On Water Group office (OWG).

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the signal mast on the clubhouse north-east lawn.

5. CLUB COURSES

SS27 courses are attached to these SSIs.

5.1 Day Buoy



Flag Q

Flag 'Q' displayed at the warning signal indicates a yellow Day Buoy has been laid to windward of the starting line.

a) Flag 'Q' with a red Port flag means 'After starting, boats shall round the yellow Day Buoy and then the red Clearance Buoy, leaving both to port, before continuing to the first mark of the course.'

b) Flag 'Q' with a green Starboard flag means 'After starting, boats shall round the yellow Day Buoy and then the green Clearance Buoy, leaving both to starboard, before continuing to the first mark of the course.'

5.2 Missing Mark

If a mark is missing and Flag 'M' is not in position, boats shall round in the marks usual position. This changes RRS 34.

5.3 Courses

The course to be sailed will be designated by an international numeral pennant corresponding to the course number displayed below the division or class flag.

6. AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

While racing, the area and the imaginary lines listed below are designated obstructions that boats shall not enter, or cross, as applicable:



- a) The area encompassing the northern point of the western hardstand, Heathcote Channel and Heathcote Spit (22) as shown in the diagram below:
- b) All navigation posts carrying top marks (except Outer Dolphin (17), Foam Spit (18) and Deepwater Spit (37)) shall not rank as marks but shall rank as obstructions for the purpose of RRS 19.

- c) While racing, all navigation posts carrying top marks, except Outer Dolphin (17), Foam Spit (18) and Deepwater Spit (37), shall be passed on their correct navigational side.

7. TIME LIMIT

The time limit is 1730

8. PRIZES

Pennants will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place based on corrected time and elapsed time.
