## 1. COVID-19 REGULATIONS

- 1.1. Racing will be conducted in accordance with Federal and State legislation relating to COVID-19. Skippers are responsible for deciding whether to participate or not, and for compliance with all applicable rules and regulations, including all COVID regulations.

## 2. RESPONSIBILITY

- 2.1. Responsibility: All those taking part in the race do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Organising Authority, South of Perth Yacht Club and their respective officers, employees, volunteers, and members, accept no liability for any injury, loss or damage that may be suffered by any competitor.
- 2.2. Specific attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 3 – Decision to Race.

## 3. RULES

- 3.1 The Organising Authority is South of Perth Yacht Club (Inc.)
- 3.2 The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in:
  - 3.2.1 The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024;
  - 3.2.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) category 3;
  - 3.2.3 The ORWA Sailing Instructions 2021 – 2022;
  - 3.2.4 These Supplementary Sailing Instructions.
- 3.3 In the event of a conflict, the Supplementary Sailing Instructions will take precedence.

## 6. PRE-RACE RADIO CHECKS

- 6.1. Centaur Run mandatory pre-race radio check – Fremantle Sailing Club Race Office will be open at 0830 hours Saturday 09<sup>th</sup> October 2021 for radio checks on VHF Channel 72.

## 7. COURSES

- 7.1. Appendix A shall list the courses when changed from the ORWA Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2. The course to be sailed will be designated by an international numeral pennant corresponding to that course number, displayed below the course flag.

## 8. MARKS

- 8.1. The port end start mark will be a black & white chequered cylindrical inflatable buoy.
- 8.2. The day buoy will be a yellow conical inflatable buoy.

## 9. EXCLUSION ZONES

- 9.2. While racing boats shall not enter the following areas
    - 9.2.1. Fremantle Harbour Entrance as defined in ORWA Sailing Instruction 7
    - 9.2.2. Swanbourne Military Exercise Area as defined by DoT Nautical Chart WA 001 OCEAN REEF to CAPE PERON
- For the purpose of the RRS the areas are an obstruction and the limit of safe passage.

## 10. STARTING AREA

- 10.1. The starting area will be in the vicinity of Hall Bank Beacon.

## 11. POSITION REPORTING

- 11.1. Scheduled position reports as specified in ORWA Sailing Instruction 17.2 will NOT be required.
- 11.2. VHF Channel 72 will be monitored for the duration of the race
- 11.3. Mandatory Rounding Reports:

All divisions will report to race control by radio when rounding Centaur Reef South Cardinal Mark via VHF Ch 72. ORWA Sailing Instruction 17.3.3 and 17.4 applies.
- 11.4. Boats shall maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channels 72 and 16 at all times during the event.

## 12. TIME LIMIT

- 12.1. There is no time limit

## 13. PRIZES & PRESENTATIONS

- 13.1. Pennants will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd & fastest for each division (PHS & IRC).
- 13.2. Additional prizes may be awarded as the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 13.3. Results presentations will be announced at South of Perth Yacht Club at 1800 on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2021.
