## 7. DAY BUOY

7.1 **Flag 'Q'** displayed at the warning signal indicates a yellow Day Buoy has been laid to windward of the start line.

- a) **Flag 'Q'** with a red Port flag means "after starting, boats shall round the yellow Day Buoy and then round the red Clearance Buoy, leaving both to port, before continuing to the first mark of the course.
- b) **Flag 'Q'** with a green starboard flag means "after starting, boats shall round the yellow day buoy and then the green Clearance Buoy, leaving both to starboard, before continuing to the first mark of the course.
