SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Incorporating the S80 Assoc. Swan River Championship
S97 Assoc. Windward / Leeward Series
SS27 Assoc. Short Course Series

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the following rules:

- a) The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- b) Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 1 for Keelboats – Category 7
- c) The SoPYC General Notice of Race, Saturday Series Sailing Instructions
- d) These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs)
- e) In the event of conflict, these SSIs will take precedence over the Saturday Series Sailing Instructions.

2. SCHEDULE OF RACES

3. RACING AREAS

Racing will be conducted in the area known as Melville Water East (MWE) adjacent to South of Perth Yacht Club.

4. COURSES & MARKS

The courses and marks to be used are as described in Attachment A.

5. START & FINISH

5.1 Races will be started by using RRS 26 amended as follows:

Minutes before Starting signal	Visual Signal	Sound Signal	Meaning
3	Class flag	One	Warning signal
2	P, U or Black flag	One	Preparatory signal
1	Preparatory flag removed	One long	One minute to start signal
0	Class flag removed	one	Starting signal

- 5.2 The Race Committee's intention is to start in the order as described in SSI 2, however to avoid delays, they may start fleet's in an alternative order and may combine fleets.
- 5.3 The start and finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the SoPYC Race Committee boat at the starboard end and black and white chequered inflatable buoy at the port end.

6. TIME LIMITS & TARGET TIMES

Time limits and target times in minutes are as follows:

Time Limit	Finish Window	Target Time
40 mins	5 mins	30 mins

- 6.1 If no boat sails the course and finishes within the Time Limit for the first boat, then the race will be abandoned.
- 6.2 Boats failing to finish within the time stated in the finish window after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS35, A4 and A5.
- 6.3 Failure to meet the target times will not be grounds for redress. [NP]

7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Windward/Leeward Series will be based on Performance Handicaps.
- 7.2 Initial handicaps will be set prior to the commencement of the first race. Only one handicap per boat will be issued.
- 7.3 Association Invitation races will be scored first, second and third places across the line in each race where handicaps have not been provided.
- 7.4 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.5 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. PRESENTATION

- 8.1 Pennants will be presented at South of Perth Yacht Club commencing as soon as practicable after the last race.
- 8.2 Pennants will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd overall in each fleet.

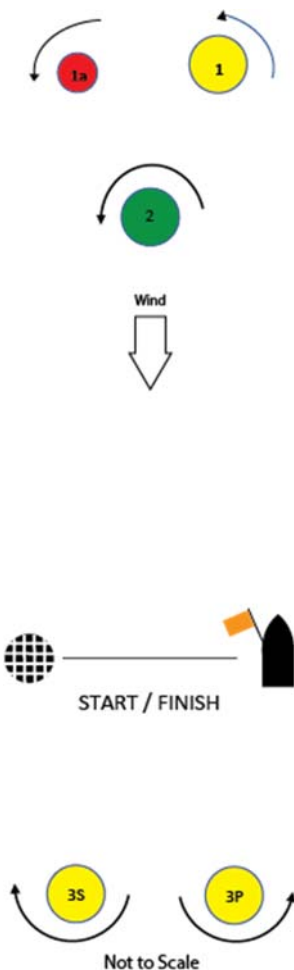

1a	Red inflatable cylindrical buoy
2	Green inflatable buoy
Start / Finish	Black and white chequered inflatable buoy
