SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

- 1.1 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in:
 - a) The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
 - b) S80 Legends Day NOR.
- 1.2 In the event of a conflict, these SSI's shall take precedence.

3. CLASS FLAG

The class flag will be the black S80 insignia on a white background.

5. THE START AND FINISH

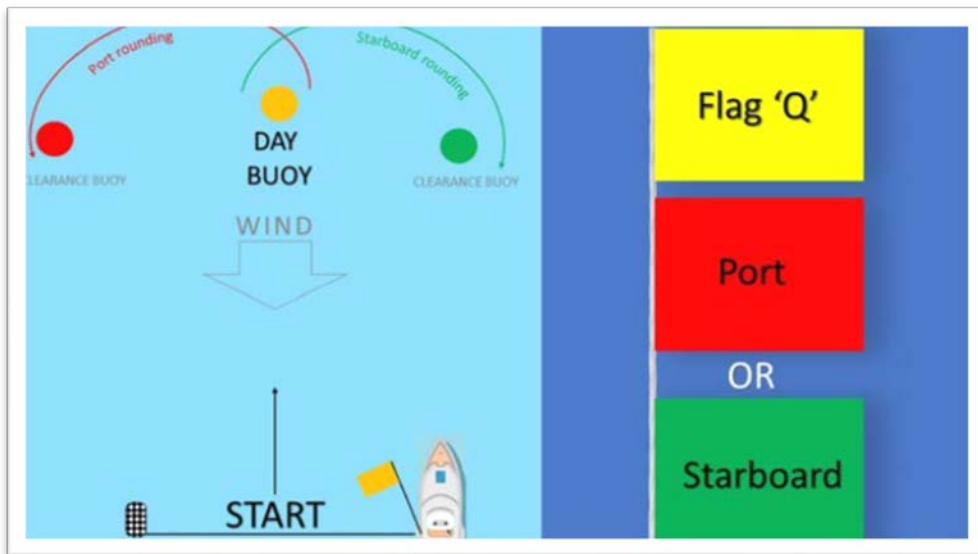
- 5.1 The Mid-River Start Line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee vessel at the starboard end and a black and white chequered inflatable buoy at the port end.
- 5.2 A buoy may be attached to the stern of the Race Committee boat. Boats shall not pass between this buoy and the Race Committee boat at any time.

6. DAY BUOY

Flag 'Q' displayed at the warning signal indicates a yellow Day Buoy has been laid to windward of the starting line.

- a) Flag 'Q' with a red Port flag means 'After starting, boats shall round the yellow Day Buoy and then the red Clearance Buoy, leaving both to port, before continuing to the first mark of the course.'

- b) Flag 'Q' with a green Starboard flag means 'After starting, boats shall round the yellow Day Buoy and then the green Clearance Buoy, leaving both to starboard, before continuing to the first mark of the course (Refer Diagram below).



7. OBSTRUCTIONS

While racing, the area and the imaginary lines listed below are designated obstructions that boats shall not enter, or cross, as applicable:

- The area encompassing the northern point of the western hardstand, Heathcote Channel and Heathcote Spit (22) as shown in the following page.
- All navigation posts carrying top marks (except Outer Dolphin (17), Foam Spit (18) and Deepwater Spit (37)) shall not rank as marks but shall rank as obstructions for the purpose of RRS 19. c)
- While racing, all navigation posts carrying top marks, except Outer Dolphin (17), Foam Spit (18) and Deepwater Spit (37), shall be passed on their correct navigational side.

8. SCORING

Boats shall be scored in the order they cross the finish line.

9. BERTHING

Visiting boats to SoPYC may be berthed at any of the temporary berthing locations prior to and after racing as indicated below:

Results presentations are announced in the SoPYC Ballroom area of the main clubhouse no earlier than 1700.

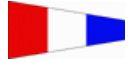
